

Firebox Support Kit for ICON60 & ICON100

Phillips screwdriver Stubby phillips screwdriver Drill 3/32 drill bit Pencil or pointed marker (Sharpie)





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Components



Appliance Preparation

A. Remove Screen Front

٠ Locate spring pins in upper LH and RH corners of front. Pull down on pin to release front and rotate top of front away from appliance.

B. Remove External Refractory

- Lift up on the right side refractory so that swedge pin (see • Figure 2.3) clears hole in glass frame.




Figure 2.4 **Clear Top Pin**

- Lower and pull bottom of refractory forward until the top ٠ pin clears hole in glass frame. See Figure 2.4.
- Repeat for left side refractory.

Grasp front hearth refractory and slide forward from

underneath side refractory panels. See Figure 2.2.

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C. Glass Panel Assembly

- To remove the glass panel assembly, release glass latches (six in ICON60I, ten in ICON100I). Lift glass frame assembly
 carefully off bottom glass support and set aside.
- To reinstall the glass panel assembly, center glass panel in opening, set on lower glass latches, tilt top in and fasten all glass latches.
- Refer to Figure 2.5.



D. Remove the Andirons


Figure 2.6 Andiron Brackets

- Locate two screws holding the andirons (one per andiron). See Figure 2.6.
- Loosen screws, but do not remove them.
- Slide each andiron away from screw head toward firebox sides. Lift andirons and tip towards logs to remove.

E. Burner and Pilot Access

• Remove front hearth refractory. See Figure 2.7.



- Remove three top logs.
- Remove two screws holding grate. See Figure 2.8.



 Remove left and right bottom side refractories. See Figure 2.10.

- Remove two screws attaching the pilot to the burner.


Figure 2.11 Removing Burner Support Screws

- Remove four burner support screws. See Figure 2.11.

Lift and remove grate and log assembly. See Figure 2.9.

• Slide the burner to the right, out of the air shutter. Lift and remove burner. See Figure 2.12.



- Loosen left side refractory retainer and remove refractory by sliding it forward and out. See Figure 2.13.

- Loosen right side refractory retainer and remove refractory by sliding it forward and out.
- Remove back refractorey retainer by removing two screws. Tip top of refractory forward and lift out.



A. Remove False Back

Remove screws holding firebox false back. After screws are removed, slide false back to bottom of the firebox, tip the top of the false back forward until it clears all obstacles, lift and remove. Reserve the screws to use again in Section 3.D.

B. Template

The template has nine holes in it. The inner and outer sets of holes are for an ICON60. The middle set of holes is for an ICON100.


The bottom of the template has a chamfered corner (45-degree cut). This is always on the outside bottom.


ICON60

- Set the template against the firebox back with the chamfered corner against the outside bottom of the fireplace (right or left side, template is reversible). The side of the template should line up squarely with the side of the firebox where the side meets the back.
- Hold the template firmly in place and put dots on the firebox back (with a pencil or marker) through the inner and outer sets of holes. Refer to Figure 3.1.

ICON100


- Set the template on the firebox bottom and against the firebox back with the chamfered (45-degree cut) corner in the bottom left of the firebox.
- Make sure the template is sitting square on the bottom of the firebox, tight against the firebox back and butted up to the left side of the firebox.
- Hold the template firmly in place and put dots on the firebox back (with a pencil or marker) through the inner row of holes. See Figure 3.2.
- Rotate the template 180 degrees so the chamfered corner is in the back, bottom right corner of the firebox.
- Align as you did with the left side and mark through the holes.





C. Attach Firebox Supports

- Using a 3/32 in. drill bit, drill through the dots you drew on the firebox back.
- Align the larger holes in the supports with the holes you drilled in the firebox box, and attach the support with the screws provided.
- The flanges (of the supports) fastened to the firebox back should face the center of the unit. See Figure 3.3.




Final Steps

A. Reinstall All Other Parts

Reinstall the parts removed in Section 2 in reverse order. Refer to Figure 2.5.

D. Attach New False Back

- Attach the outside edges of the new false back (provided with kit) with the screws saved from Section 3.A.
- Use the screws profided with this kit to attach the false back to the supports installed in Section 3.C.



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
