

ALLUSION HERITAGE BLACK GLASS ACCESSORY KITS

- Installation Instructions -

CAUTION! Risk of Cuts, Abrasions or Flying Debris.
Wear protective gloves and safety glasses during installation. Sheet metal edges are sharp.

Do not discard and leave with product. These instructions are required at different times.

Introduction

The Allusion Heritage Black Glass Accessory Kits are designed to replace the included brick side panels and the glass back panel to give a black reflective look to the Allusion Heritage 36" (SF-ALLH36) or the Allusion Heritage 42" (SF-ALLH42).

Kit Components

Remove contents from packaging and verify all pieces are included before beginning installation.

Black Glass Magnetic Side Panels (Left & Right)	2
Black Glass Back Panel	1
ST4x8 Screws	11

Tools Needed

Before beginning the installation, be sure that the following tools and building supplies are available.

- Phillips Screwdriver
- Safety Glasses
- Gloves

Prepare the Appliance

CAUTION! The appliance should be disconnected from power before kit is installed.

The brick side panels and glass back panel that came included with the appliance need to be removed to prepare the appliance for installation of the black glass accessory components.

1. Remove the front glass from the appliance by removing the two (2) screws from the top right and left corners. Set the glass and screws aside for later.

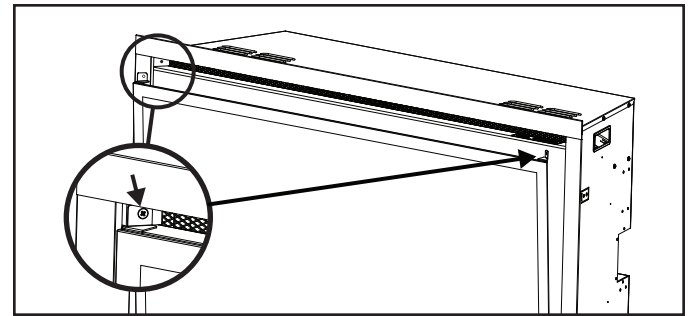


Figure 1 Front Glass Attachment Screws

2. Remove the brick side panels by removing the brackets attached to the ember bed. Remove the two (2) ST4x8 screws from each bracket.

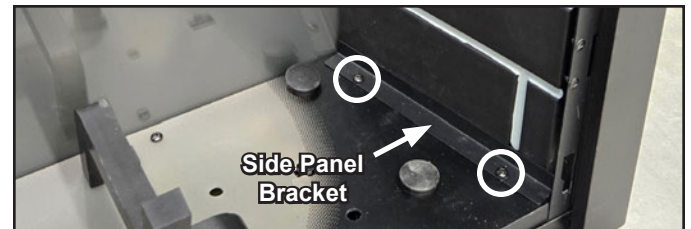


Figure 2 Side Panel Bracket Screws

NOTE: The side panel brackets are not needed to install the black glass side panels. They can be discarded or saved with the brick side panels for potential future use.

3. Grab the side panels by a corner and pull out to disconnect the magnets from each side panel and remove them from the appliance.
4. Remove the back bracket holding the top of the glass back panel in place by removing the ST4x8 screws attaching the back bracket to the appliance. Set the bracket aside for later.

5. Use the suction cup, provided with the appliance, to attach to the glass back panel. Lift up and out to remove the glass from the appliance.

NOTE: The flame screen behind the glass back panel should not be removed from the appliance.

Installation

Make sure all previous steps have been completed before installation of the black glass accessory.

1. With the flame screen in place inside of the appliance, slide the black glass back panel into the appliance. Make sure the flame screen and the black glass are in the back channel equally.

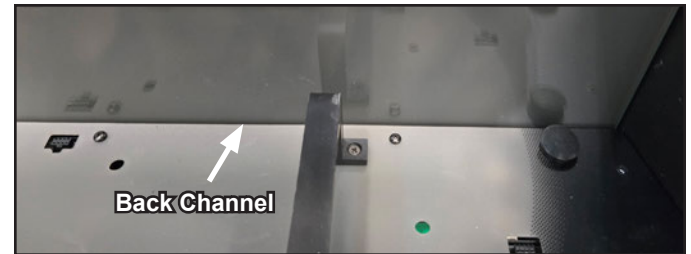


Figure 5 Flame Screen and Glass Back Channel

2. Once the black glass back panel is in the back channel, push the top of the black glass back until it rests against flame screen and the internal bracket.
3. Use the ST4x8 screws to re-attach the top bracket to hold the flame screen and black glass in place.

NOTE: If the bracket is not lining up with the screw holes, verify the black glass back panel is fully seated into the back channel.

4. Take a black glass side panel and slide the top end of the panel into the side of the appliance. Then slide the bottom in until it meets with the side of the appliance. Magnets will engage to hold the side panels in place.

NOTE: The side panel brackets are not needed to install the black glass side panels.

5. Reference the Heritage manual (SF-ALLH-MAN) for finishing instruction.



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
